

Release Notes Available for Updates to EarlyCheck the Weekend of January 22

Fannie Mae has issued release notes detailing additional updates to EarlyCheck™ (via the Web-based user interface and direct integration) scheduled for the **weekend of January 22, 2011**.

These updates will modify the severity or deactivate some checks to align EarlyCheck with the Loan Delivery application and temporarily deactivate other checks for correction in a subsequent release:

- **Check E735**, checking that the unit number is in the expected range, will change from a Fatal check to a Warning check to align with Loan Delivery.
- DU® Compare **Check ED41**, comparing non-manufactured homes/non-co-op property types, will change from a Fatal check to a Warning check to align with Loan Delivery.
- DU Compare **Check ED104**, comparing T Project Classifications, will be turned off to align with Loan Delivery.
- DU Compare **Check ED50**, comparing standardized property city, will be turned off to align with Loan Delivery.
- **Check E1011**, FHA loan limit exceeded, will be turned off until further notice.
- **Check E1098**, VA loan limit exceeded, will be turned off until further notice.
